



## **Sprig Mola Mug Rug-Hand Reverse Applique**

All levels at Paducah, 2024. Class 343503

### **SUPPLY LIST**

#### **Required**

Batiks are required. Molasses are colorful. Four contrasting yet coordinating colors. Typically, they have a dark top fabric and a bright middle layer.

1 – 8 ½” x 8 ½” sq. dark batik, top fabric (black).

1 – 8 ½” x 8 ½” sq. contrast batik, middle fabric (purple).

1 – 8 ½” x 8 ½” sq. contrast background fabric (green).

1 – 8 ½” x 8 ½” sq. accent batik applique fabric (blue).

No. 7 Sharps needle for basting\*

No. 11 Milliner’s needle for hand stitching\*

#### **Plus bring to class**

- (1) spool of 60 wt., 80 wt., **OR** silk thread – stitching (SAME COLORS as top, middle and accent batiks)
- (1) pair of small, sharp scissors (Kai slightly blunt-tipped scissors recommended)
- (4-5) safety pins – pin basting
- (4-5) straight pins
- Light box (to trace design onto wrong side of background batik)
- White marking pencil and/**OR** Frixion gel pen – tracing pattern onto wrong side of background batik
- Clover blue washable marker
- Fabric Eraser
- Small ruler (2" x 4" **OR** 4" x 4")
- Needle threader – small-eyed needle (optional)

Helpful item: Beam N’ Read personal light, desktop needle threader.

**\*Materials Fee** cost = \$28.00

**Sprig Mola Mug Rug** print pattern (required for class),

(1) No.7 sharp needle – basting,

(1) No.11 Milliner’s needle – stitching,

(1) spool of 12 wt. thread – basting,
