SUPPLY LIST: (Bring to Class)*

Required patterns: *Sweetheart Sorbet*, *Medallion XII pattern* and *Practice piece* pattern. Place Order for required patterns through the Hot Springs Valley Quilt Guild by emailing amylohoyt@yahoo.com.

Fabrics: Batiks or good quality hand-dyes are strongly recommended. Pre-wash and iron fabrics before first class. Colors stated are what we used and are only as a reference.

- 1 – 30" x 30" light-medium batik for background (red/orange in picture)
- 1 – 30" x 30" dark batik for top (Purple in picture)
- 1 FQ each of Orchid (hearts), Green (leaves), Turquoise (circles) and Yellow (petals) applique
- 1 - 9" x 11" rectangle, background fabric, for practice.



Soft Fuse*:

- 1 – 26" x 26" square
- ½ yard for appliqué

Terial Magic spray-on stabilizer* or stabilizer of choice

1 spool each of 40 or 50 wt. thread for satin stitch (SAME COLOR as top and appliqué fabrics)

1 pair small, sharp scissors*- our Kai 4" bent-handled sharp-tipped scissors recommended

10 - 20 straight or safety pins

Mechanical pencil for tracing pattern onto paper side of fusible

Sewing machine with zig-zag or satin stitch

80/12 sewing machine needle

Open-toed sewing machine foot

Iron, ironing board

Light box to trace design onto fusible and to position appliqué (may be helpful)



Optional: For Appli-quilting:

- 1 – 34" x 34" square backing fabric
- 1 – 34" x 34" square **batting**
- 1 – 90/14 sewing machine needle instead of 80/12 needle
